

Kiwanis Blogs – Frequently Asked Questions

I'm new to blogging – what is it really?

Blog is a contraction of the words "Web log." Think of it as an online commentary or diary which is published by an individual and allows the audience the opportunity to comment on the entry or post.

Where do I find blogs on KiwanisOne?

From most pages in KiwanisOne, you are only two clicks away from the [main blog page](#). Click the Kiwanis Community tab (across the top just below the logo banner), then click the Blog tab which brings you to the [main blog page](#).

By default, you will see a list of the most recently posted blog entries. If you click "view all blog posts," you can also change the view to display the most viewed blogs or the blogs with the most comments. Click the title to open the full blog posting.

How many blogs are there on KiwanisOne?

The number of blogs on KiwanisOne may vary over time, so check out the orange index box called "Blogs on this Site" (right column of the [main blog page](#)). Our blogs are broken down into topic areas and their titles include:

- Kiwanis Public News
- Leadership Matters
- Kiwanis News
- KiwanisOne Change Log
- Kiwanis Dashboard Blog
- The Junk Drawer
- KI Center Stage

How do I add my comment to a blog entry?

Click the links to the full blog posting and scroll down to the Add a Comment section. Remember to click on the Add button to submit your comment.

I made a comment but it doesn't look like it posted.

It can take a bit of time for a new comment to display below the blog entry since all comments are moderated. This allows the blogger to filter out any inappropriate advertising or other mischief that shouldn't be posted. However, comments are not at all altered or edited and appear exactly as you author them.

Can I make an anonymous comment?

Yes. Remember, if you are already logged in on the site as a KiwanisOne member, you will need to log off before making your comment as an anonymous visitor. Once you are on the appropriate blog page, scroll down to the comment section and simply enter initials or another ID into the comment name field (since it's a required field) or the system won't accept your comment.

Is there an easy way to keep up with my favorite blog?

You can subscribe to a [RSS news feed](#) of the blog or receive a new post alert by typing in your e-mail address – both options are available to you in the orange "Syndication" box to the left of the blog post.
