Suggestions:

1. **Distribute [Builders Club Recruitment Cards](#).** Be present at registration, open houses and parent nights. Distribute brochures to faculty and ask that they give information to students and direct interested students to you.
2. **Hang up [posters](#).** Display information about the first meeting or service project.
3. **Make Announcements.** Let interested students know about Builders Club. Provide an invitation flier/enrollment form announcing the organizational meeting date and time.
4. **Get recommendations.** Via the school principal, collect Builders Club membership recommendations from faculty. Students recommended for membership should be interested in service and of good character and leadership potential.
5. **Tell parents.** Send a letter home informing the parents of their children's recommendation for Builders Club membership.
6. **Recruit.** Have members invite their friends to attend meetings and projects. Encourage these friends to join the club.
